36TH ANNUAL NATIONAL FALCON SHOW

July 9 – 11, 2015

The Northeast Chapter of the Falcon Club of America is hosting the 2015 National Falcon Show. It is being held at the Crowne Plaza in Warwick, Rhode Island. The Committee has been working hard to get all the events lined up and the show field laid out.

We have events planned for Thursday, July 9th and Friday, July Show10th with the show being held on Saturday, July 11th. Please take a look at what we have to offer and register soon.

We will be visiting Factory Five Racing on Thursday morning with a stop at Tasca Ford in the afternoon. These tours are at no cost but they are self-driving tours. We will also be having the Annual Ladies' Tea on Thursday afternoon. It is being held at the hotel from 1:30 – 3:30.

On Thursday afternoon/ evening, we will be driving to a local beach, Oakland Beach, for a cruise night. This is located right on the waterfront. There are local restaurants there that you will be able to walk to so you can enjoy a variety of foods, from seafood to steaks, pastas or chicken. They have something for everyone. We plan to leave the hotel between 4:00 – 4:30 to beat the rush to the beach and return by about 7:00.

On Friday, we have planned a bus trip to Newport with a visit to the Breakers Mansion. The cost of the trip is \$30.00 for adults and

\$20.00 for children. This includes the bus and the admission to the Breakers. One of our members will be our tour guide. The bus will leave the hotel at 8:30 and return by 1:30. We are limited to 50 people and it will be on a first come, first serve basis.

We also have a bus tour of Jonathan Edwards Winery in North Stonington, CT scheduled for Friday at 2:00 and will return to the Hotel at 4:30. The cost of the Winery is \$25.00 per person, adults only. We are limited to 30 people for the winery and this will also be on a first come, first serve basis.

Friday evening the club will be providing a pizza party to our guests followed by an ice cream social. We hope to host a drive-in movie while we enjoy our ice cream. The drive-in is tentative right now.

The Main Event will be held on Saturday, beginning at 8:00 a.m. Voting will begin at 10:00 and end at 12:00. This will give our ballot counters time to calculated the votes and hopefully have pictures ready to show you at the banquet of all of our winners. We will also have the Valve Cover Races on Saturday beginning at 12:00. If you haven't been to a National Meet before, this has become a big event. We started this is 2001 with a hill in the parking lot of the hotel and boy has it grown since then! It includes a full length of wood track with starting gate and end zone. Everyone will have the same wood base, wheels and axles so all racers have the same advantage.

The show culminates with our banquet on Saturday evening.

Will you be attending your first Falcon Club National Convention this year? By Ray Chevalier

For most Northeast Chapter members that will be attending this year's FCA National Convention, which our Chapter will be hosting, it will be your first. As a veteran of many of these events over the years I would like to pass on a few things that I have learned, and hopefully make the experience a little easier for the first timers.

One of the first things to think about when you register is placing your Falcon in the correct category, and class within that category. All the information is listed on the Chapter's web site at www.northeastchapter.com.

There are 5 Categories that can be used. Stock, Lite Modified, Modified, Daily/Street Driven and Diamond in the Rough. Below is a brief description of each category.

- 1. Stock Category: Falcons entered in this category have historically been thoroughly detailed while maintaining a high percentage of authenticity. The key being: maintaining a high percentage of authenticity. Radial Tires and different wheels are acceptable in this category.
- 2. Lite Modified: This Category is for that Falcon that retains the stock appearance but has been mildly modified to improve the safety, performance and drivability/handling. Note: this

category was created for the stock looking Falcons that have a few non-original changes made to it, but not so many as to be placed in with modified Falcons. An example would be a Falcon with disc brakes or non-original motor.

- 3. Modified Category: This category is wide open! You will find Customs, Sleds, Racers, Chopped Tops, Full Frames, Tubs, 4-Wheel Disc Brakes, Monster Tires. Anything goes in this category.
- 4. Daily/Street Driven: As the name implies, this category is for those special Falcons that you see on the street every day! It should have lots of bugs in the radiator.
- 5. Diamond in the Rough: As the name implies, this category is for the Falcon that needs work or is in the process of being restored.


 These Falcons may be in primer.

If all entries place their Falcons in the correct categories the event will be as fair to all as we can make it. If a Falcon is not in a category that it should be in, we as the Committee, will suggest that they move to the appropriate category, and explain why, but that is all we can do - make a suggestion. Some classes will be large and some will be small. That is the nature of the beast, as they say. Some years and models are more popular than others. What we will do is have extra awards for the larger classes to create fairness to all. So before you fill out your registration form, which our Chairlady Cris Bowes hopes you do soon, be sure to check the Chapter's web site for a full description of each category and the classes within that category to
