In the fall of 1998, the Chapter was asked if we could host a National Convention in 2001. We formed a steering committee of about 5 couples. Of all the members of the committee, Ginny and I were the only ones that had ever attended a National Convention. So putting such an event together was, at best, "flying by the seat of our pants." But Kathy always kept us moving ahead in the right direction.

Kathy became the Secretary of the committee. As the work of the committee continued through the winter of 1998 and the spring 1999 we ran into many difficult situations that we could not agree on. But it was Kathy that always seemed to come up with the solution that would work and all could live with.

We decided to put together a proposal to be submitted at the 1999 Convention in Charlotte to host the 2001 National Convention. Throughout my time as a National Board member, I saw many proposals submitted. Many were very brief and lacked much information. Kathy decided to put together a proposal that would leave no questions unanswered. She had letters from the Governor, Mayor, and the host hotel with every activity spelled out in detail. The proposal was 30 plus pages

bound with an index. She mailed a copy to each National Board member two weeks before they were to vote, to give them a chance to review the information. If the Falcon Club had a museum, that proposal would be displayed there. At the 2001 Convention banquet, we awarded Kathy with a special award for being the outstanding member that made the Convention the success that it was.

When we talked about club shirts and jackets, Kathy handled the whole thing. Kathy then continued to help First Lady Cris with Regional Meet registrations. Kathy served as Secretary up until a couple of years ago when her health caused her to give it up. Kathy, I am sure, was the longest serving Officer the Chapter has ever had.

So, as we move into the future without our beloved friend, she will always be remembered as Madam Secretary. Kathy always gave 100% effort in everything she did. I think I can speak for all Chapter members that knew her when I say she helped make the Northeast Chapter the great organization that it is. Thank you for your years of warm friendship. God speed Madam Secretary.


